



Privacy Notice for TrySports Schools Competition Participants and Affiliates

REVISED NOVEMBER 2023

Introduction

This privacy notice explains how TrySports (referred to as "we", "our", or "us") may use personal information collected before, during, and after the TrySports Schools competition. We are committed to respecting your privacy and ensuring compliance with data protection laws. We are the data controller of any personal information we hold.

Data Protection and GDPR Compliance

We adhere to the UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), ensuring personal data is:

- Processed lawfully, fairly, and transparently.
- Collected for explicit and legitimate purposes.
- Adequate, relevant, and limited to necessary purposes.
- Accurate and kept up to date.
- Retained only as long as necessary.

Applicability

This notice applies to:

- Students and staff from participating schools.
- Officials and volunteers involved in organizing and managing the competition.
- Individuals interacting with TrySports regarding the competition, including inquiries and logistics.

Personal information we collect

We may collect:

- Contact details (e.g., name, email address, telephone number).
- School details (e.g., school name, address, staff contact information).
- Records of interactions with us (e.g., emails, telephone conversations).
- Attendance records at events or competitions.
- Images or videos captured during events.
- Health and medical information for safeguarding purposes.

Children's Data

We handle children's data with utmost care, complying with legal requirements for consent and data processing. Consent from an adult with parental responsibility is always sought for children under the age of 13.

Special Categories of Personal Information



We may collect sensitive information (e.g., health data) based on explicit consent or as required by law, particularly for safeguarding purposes.

Collection and Use of Information

We collect information through registration forms, direct communications, and our website. This information is used to:

- Manage participation in the competition.
- Ensure safety and compliance with health and safety requirements.
- Communicate about the event, including logistics and updates.
- Address inquiries or complaints.

Data Retention

We retain personal information as long as necessary for the purposes collected, typically for a period of 6 years after the last interaction, or as required by law.

Data Protection Rights

Participants have rights regarding their personal data, including access, rectification, erasure, and objecting to processing. These rights can be exercised by contacting us.

Changes to Privacy Notice

We may update this privacy notice periodically. Significant changes will be communicated as required by law.
